

2025 Honorary Chairperson

DR. STANLEY ZINBERG

Dr. Stanley Zinberg proudly supports East End Hospice, and the incredible staff and volunteers who contribute to East End Hospice's five-star rating. The naming of the Zinberg Family Bereavement Center in 2021 stands as a testament to Dr. Zinberg's deep commitment to EEH.

Dr. Zinberg is an obstetrician/gynecologist who served as Vice President for Practice Activities and Deputy Executive Vice-President for the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in Washington, DC until his retirement in 2007. Dr. Zinberg was in clinical practice in New York City for 27 years and directed the obstetrics and gynecology program at the New York Downtown Hospital. He is a past president of the New York Obstetrical Society and the Bellevue Obstetrics and Gynecology Society and is the author of numerous editorials and scientific papers in the field of women's healthcare. He received a Master's Degree in Health Science from the Wagner School of Public Administration of New York University and has held faculty appointments at the New York University School of Medicine, Cornell University College of Medicine and Georgetown University School of Medicine. For many years he served as an examiner for the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Zinberg is a member of the Community Advisory Board of Directors of the Peconic Bay Medical Center and a member of the PBMC Foundation Board. He was a director of the Board and former Chairman of the Board of the Westhampton Beach Performing Arts Center. He served as a member of the New York State Board for Professional Medical Conduct and as a member of the Board of Ethics of the Town of Southampton. Dr. Zinberg was a Director on the Board of The Cooper Companies, a NY Stock Exchange company, for 23 years until 2018.



24th Annual Dorothy P. Savage Good Samaritan Award Recipient **CHIP TUFANO & FAMILY**

The Tufano family has been deeply entrenched in the local community for decades - serving friends and neighbors in East Moriches and beyond. Chip, his wife Kerri (Hayes) and children Hanna, Kyleigh, Meaghan and Charlie truly recognize the importance of giving back to the organizations that support and improve their amazing community.

Chip Tufano started Chip's Evergreen with just a lawn mower in the back of his father's car more than 40 years ago. Since his start in 1989, Chip's hard work and dedication to his customers has grown the company to what it is today, now servicing over 200 properties in the area. Chip's signature style of care and concern for others has led to a strong foundation of business and personal relationships throughout the community. As a family business, Kerri works alongside Chip as Vice-President and CFO of Chip's Evergreen.



Chip joined the East Moriches Fire Department at an early age and has served as a firefighter for 35 years. He was named Firefighter of the Year in 2000 and in 2006 in recognition of his service and bravery, and is currently a trustee of the EMFD. Through the years Kerri has assisted with EMFD fundraisers, including organizing an annual fundraising bus trip to participate in the Tunnel to Towers 5K. Proceeds from the event support the Tunnel to Towers Foundation's programs, including those benefitting first responders, and catastrophically injured service members.

With help from Chip, Kerri created CAARE, a foundation to increase community awareness of autism, support research and improve the education of children with autism. Through community and fundraising events, CAARE raised over \$30,000 to support families with children with autism.

Kerri has been a member of the East Moriches PTO for several years, serving as treasurer for three years. In her role there she helped organize many events including the EMO Turkey Trot 5K race.

The Tufano family has always been passionate about supporting local youth sports, particularly lacrosse. Kerri championed the WHB girls' lacrosse program as Team Mom for many years - as all three of the Tufano girls played for the Lady Hurricanes. Kyleigh continued to play lacrosse at Fairfield University, where Kerri and Chip quickly found a home helping to support the teams there as well. Meaghan will be joining the lacrosse team at Hofstra University in the Fall.

In addition, the family supports many other local organizations including the athletic teams and robotic club at Westhampton Beach High School. The Tufanos have recently begun to work with local founders Steve and Teresa Webb and their non-profit Team Up 4 Community, an organization that encourages athletes and all individuals to take decisive action to create positive and lasting change in their local and global communities.

The Tufano children have followed in their parents' footsteps of community service with Hanna volunteering her time with political campaigns locally and at American University. Kyleigh served on the NCAA Student Athlete Advisory Committee and as a Morgan's Message Ambassador. Meaghan also served as a Morgan's Message Ambassador, and Charlie participates in National Junior Honor Society volunteer opportunities.
